The EHA hit the ground running the first month of the new year responding to the EU 2020 consultation and preparing its Electric Transport Infrastructure session in collaboration with HyRaMP, the Westmidlands in Europe office and ERTRAC, at the EU Sustainable Energy Week, on March 23, 2010 from 1400- 1700 hrs at the Palais des Academies Rue Ducale 1 in Brussels.

The session already saw the confirmation of responsible officers at DG Enterprise on the Green Car Initiative, the EIB transport expert and EUCAR. Objective of the session is to facilitate more coordination at EU, national and local level of infrastructure developments for battery and fuel cell powered vehicles. The session is taking place at an especially important moment as the new Commission has just been appointed by the EU Parliament and the EU Spanish presidency announced plans for an EU Electric Car Action Plan. Although no final decisions on the responsible Commissioner for the JTI were communicated when this report went to press it is clear that the first half of 2010 will be a critical to put hydrogen on the new EU policy map.
